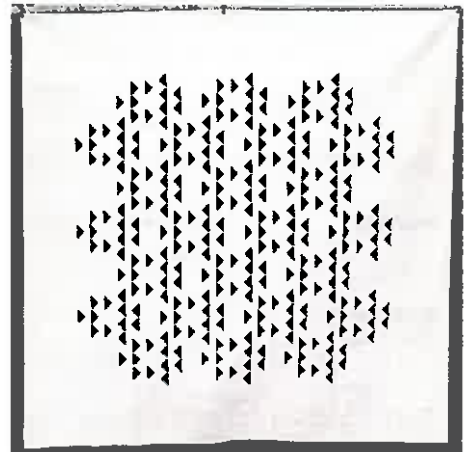

May Charity Block Wonky Log Cabin by Quilt Dad

Example of block construction: <http://www.quilt dad.com/2009/09/quilt-along-3-wonky-log-cabin-block.html>

12.5" Finished Block –Red, White, Cream, Blue

- 1) Start with a 2.5" center block. Trim the first side with a slant before sewing the first log.
 - 2) Once the first log is sewn onto the center piece, rotate the block 90° to the right or left and stick with whichever direction you choose for the rest of the block.
 - 3) Continue adding logs to complete each ring. About 4-5 rings will yield a 12.5" block.
- *For added contrast, keep the lighter fabrics to one side of the block!
