DAMQG Charity BOM – Feb 2023

Our February charity block is the Sunday Morning pattern from the book *Sunday Morning Quilts* by Cheryl Arkinson and Amanda Jean Nyberg. It's a quick and simple block you can make from your scraps, so consider making more than one to bring to our March meeting or pop in the mail if you can't come in person.

Colors: purple, pink, grey and black

Unfinished Block Size: 12.5 x 12.5 inches

Block Instructions:

- 1. Sew several 10-inch strips of fabric together to create a stack at least 13 inches tall.
- 2. Cut a 3.5-inch x 13-inch strip and sew it perpendicular to the stack of stripes.
- 3. Trim block to 12.5 x 12.5 inches.
